Guadalupe River Public Access Points with Fishing

Louise Hays City Park

Location: Off Thompson Dr at Hwy 16 south

Hours: Open 7:30AM-11PM

Facilities: Public restrooms, kayak, canoe, pedal boat and tube rentals (seasonal) **Fishing:** Texas Parks and Wildlife stock trout here in winter, plus year-round bass,

sunfish, and catfish

Activities: Swimming, Fishing, Boating, Tubing/Canoeing, Picnicking, Paddle Boarding

Knapp Road Boat Ramp

Location: West of Chili's Restaurant

Hours: Open 7:30AM-11PM

Facilities: Public river access, boat ramp, parking

Cypress Park

Location: Hwy 27 West, across from Foxworth Galbraith Lumberyard **Facilities:** Public river access, boat ramp, shaded picnic tables, parking **Activities:** Swimming, Fishing, Boating, Tubing/Canoeing, Picnicking

Ingram Dam

Location: Hwy 39 West of Ingram

Facilities: Public river access, parking across the road **Fishing:** Excellent for bass fishing above and below the dam **Activities:** Swimming, Fishing, Tubing/Canoeing, Boating

Ingram Park

Location: Behind Wells Fargo Bank

Hours: Open 6AM-11PM

Facilities: Public river access, covered outdoor pavilion, public restrooms, playground,

BBQ grills, large grass lawn

Note: Walking access to the river only

Activities: Swimming, Fishing, Tubing/Canoeing, Picnicking

Ingram Boat Ramp

Location: Hwy 27 West of Ingram

Facilities: Public river access, public boat ramp, trash cans, parking

Activities: Boating

Schumachers Crossing

Location: Off Hwy 39 West, before the town of Hunt

Facilities: Public river access, parking, three covered picnic tables

Activities: Swimming, Fishing, Tubing/Canoeing, Picnicking

Arcadia Loop

Location: Off Hwy 27 West. Turn at Arcadia Loop, right turn across Bear Creek Rd and

across the bridge

Facilities: Public river access

Activities: Swimming, Fishing, Tubing/Canoeing

Indian Creek Road

Location: Off Old Ingram Loop

Note: Parking limited, walking access to river **Activities:** Swimming, Fishing, Tubing/Canoeing

Fish Species: Rainbow and "golden rainbow" trout (1-8 pound range), largemouth bass

(4-5 pound class, some up to 9+ pounds)

Best Times: March-April for both bass and trout, bass fishable through November

Size: 101 acres

Access: Accessible from Flatrock Park and Kerrville-Schreiner Park

Fishing: Popular for largemouth bass, bluegill, and warmouth **Features:** Family-friendly, boat ramps, bank fishing opportunities

Nimitz Lake

Fishing: Recommended by local anglers for bass and sunfish **Location:** Along the Guadalupe River system in Kerr County

Creek Fishing

Status: Recommended by local anglers as top fishing spot

Turtle Creek

Status: Local favorite fishing location

Goat Creek

Status: Productive fishing spot recommended by area anglers
