Overview

The Community Arts Program and Kerrville Convention and Visitors Bureau are collaborating to create a program that exhibits quality art by local artists in the Visitor Center. The Kerr-based artists' paintings, prints, photographs and mixed-media works depict the people, places and feelings that make the area special, through a diverse artistic lens. This 2024 showcase of art, is on rotating exhibition, and many of the pieces are available for purchase.

How to Submit Entries

Please submit the following for consideration:

- Completed Artist Entry Form
- Artists may submit up to five different artworks to be considered (jpeg format)

- Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

Eligibility Requirements

This project is open to all citizens, artists, including high school and university students. All levels of experience are encouraged to apply. All applicants, without regard to race, sex, religion, nationality, origin, sexual orientation, or disability will be considered. This is an open call for artists who work, reside, or attend school in Kerr County.

Design Guidelines

- Only 2D artwork will be considered; we cannot accommodate artists who exhibit artwork that requires the use of special equipment (computers, projectors, multimedia devices, etc.)
- Artwork must not contain: political statements or persons, religious references, copyrighted or trademarked material, corporate or organizational branding, or obscene references/imagery.
- Artwork cannot exceed 6X6 feet.
- Please upload/submit high-resolution digital images in JPEG or PDF format.

Notification Deadline

- Artists will be selected on a rolling basis and notified of selection via email.
- Works must be ready for display, including framing and a secure hanging device, if applicable.
- Art must be wrapped and/or prepared for transport.

Delivery of Artwork

• If selected, artwork must be arranged for delivery to the Kerrville Convention and Visitors Bureau 2108 Sidney Baker Street, Kerrville TX 78028 between the hours of 8:30-5:30pm; Monday - Friday.
